Welcome to Exeter Health Library

Where are we?

Level 2 (1st floor) of the PMS Building via the RILD Building on the RD&E Hospital site. Go through the RILD Building main entrance and follow the signs.

The library is staffed Monday-Friday, times may vary due to Covid 19 staffing levels. 24/7 access is available on request, with RD&E staff badge or a proximity card.



Who can join the library?

- All NHS staff and health care students working or on placement in NHS organisations in the local area
- Staff of other organisations providing services to NHS patients
- University of Exeter Medical School (UEMS) staff and students

Other people may use the Library for reference purposes at the discretion of the Library staff. It may be possible to join the library by paying an annual fee.

To join the library, pop into the library to fill in a registration form, or complete & return this registration form (<http://bit.ly/EHLregistration>). Proof of ID may be required. UEMS staff and students can borrow books with their UEMS ID cards.

Resources

Books

The library has a wide range of health care books.

Suggestions for purchase are always welcome.

You may borrow up to 8 books for an initial period of 4

weeks. Books can be renewed if no-one else has requested

them. We have a self-issue machine: you can borrow, return

or renew library books 24/7. Please bring your books back on time - we don't charge

fines but will invoice you for the cost of replacement book(s) after you've received 3 reminders from us.

Search for print or online journals via our A-Z journals list. Print journals held in the library are for reference use only but there are 1000's of electronic journals available to you. You will need an NHS OpenAthens account to access these.

You will need an NHS OpenAthens account to access online resources such as databases, electronic books, electronic journals and point of care resources. Register from an NHS networked PC or with an NHS e-mail address for instant registration. Once you have your account details you can access the electronic resources 24/7 from home or work.
